1P GROMMET PLIERS – Instructions

Fabric Preparation for Grommets

Use two layers of medium to heavy-weight fabric, reinforced with interfacing. Mark position of grommets. Test a grommet on swatch of fabric.

Instructions for Cutting Holes in Fabric

Pliers Tools:



Round Die Base

Inserting Tools:

Insert round die base in one side of pliers and cone punch in other side.




Cutting Holes:


1. Position fabric in pliers and center tools over mark. Squeeze pliers firmly to cut hole.

Punch

- 2. After cutting several holes, it may be necessary to clear fabric cutouts from die base. Use a strong straight pin to remove fabric cutouts from die.
- 3. If pliers' tools will not cut through your specific type of fabric, trace inside of grommet and cut hole with scissors.








Removing Tools:

Slip hook of gray tool remover inside ledge of pliers and press down to release tool.

Repeat for opposite side.

Instructions for Applying 3/8" Grommets



Metal Splitting Pink Grommet Punch Holder




Instructions:

1. Insert grommet post into hole with grommet front on right side of fabric.




2. Place washer (rounded side up) over

3. With grommet holder at bottom of pliers, place grommet, fabric and washer onto holder.




- 1. Wrong side of fabric
- Squeeze pliers firmly to apply grommet. Check for tightness; squeeze again, if necessary. The grommet will split and roll back over the washer.



Removing Tools:

Slip hook of gray tool remover inside ledge of pliers and press down to release tool. Repeat for opposite side.
